You can stay clean in a dirty world and reclaim life in the areas that have been dead.

In all my life there has not been anything that has brought more power, victory and life than the power of the Holy Spirit causing us to speak in his words of love. Absolutely amazing things happen, prayers are answered and an inner strength is manifest to overcome in all things. We know salvation kills our old man, baptism by immersion in water buries the old man, communion keeps the old man dead and now we will read how the baptism in the Holy Spirit causing us to speak His words creates new life in us. Jesus said this when speaking of the Holy Spirit;



If you feel awkward speaking you can always sing your favorite worship song and worship God. Then just flow into speaking the new words or tongues that God will give you. Remember God will not move your mouth and you may not know if it is Gods words until you speak for a time and see. Once you have been filled and you would like to see a situation changed in your life with the power of God. Then simply tell God you are praying about that situation, think in your mind about God in that situation and allow the new tongues to flow out of your mouth in worship. You will start creating new life into that situation and will start to see changes or feel new life flow.

John 14:18 I will not leave you as orphans [comfortless, desolate, bereaved, forlorn, helpless]; I will come [back] to you.

And in

John 7:38 He who believes in Me [who cleaves to and trusts in and relies on Me] as the Scripture has said, From his innermost being shall flow [continuously] springs and rivers of living water.

John 7:39 But He was speaking here of the Spirit, Whom those who believed (trusted, had faith) in Him were afterward to receive. For the [Holy] Spirit had not yet been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified (raised to honor).

Jesus has now been glorified and the Holy Spirit has been given. I have heard it said that people's last words are often their most important. As Jesus was leaving so the Holy Spirit could come he said the following as His final words;

Act 1:8 But you shall receive power (ability, efficiency, and might) when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you shall be My witnesses in Jerusalem and all Judea and Samaria and to the ends (the very bounds) of the earth.

Act 1:9 And when He had said this, even as they were looking [at Him], He was caught up, and a cloud received and carried Him away out of their sight.

Right now the Holy Spirit is available to you and wants to fill you with His power. Power to overcome addiction and create new life, power to see your marriage succeed, power wherever you need life by the Holy Spirit's power.

I suggest you get alone with Jesus and ask Him to fill you with His Holy Spirit. Surrender your mouth to Him and after asking Him to fill you just start to speak. You will know when it is the Holy Spirit as it will bring power to your prayer.

John 16:13 But when He, the Holy Spirit of Truth (the Truth-giving Spirit) comes, He will guide you into all the Truth (the whole, full Truth). For He will not speak His own message [on His own authority]; but He will tell whatever He hears [from the Father; He will give the message that has been given to Him], and He will announce and declare to you the things that are to come [that will happen in the future].

John 16:14 He will honor and glorify Me (Jesus), because He will take of (receive, draw upon) what is Mine and will reveal (declare, disclose, transmit) it to you.

John 16:15 Everything that the Father has is Mine. That is what I meant when I (Jesus) said that He [the Spirit] will take the things that are Mine and will reveal (declare, disclose, transmit) it to you.

The Holy Spirit is Gods messenger for your life. He brings the answer to your questions, He is peace and brings peace, life and gives life, He is power and the strength to live clean in a filthy world. The Holy Spirit is the Great Comforter, yet the Great Convictor. He brings great comfort through great conviction. Jesus told his disciples to wait for the Holy Spirit and we know that after Jesus ascended to heaven in the book of Acts, the Holy Spirit came to earth in a new way and transformed the lives of people. In Acts chapter two in the bible we read about the day of Pentecost and the events that followed.

The day of Pentecost was the day the Holy Spirit arrived with the power that Jesus spoke about for our lives. The Holy Spirit was already at work on the earth but Jesus spoke of a new experience with the Holy Spirit.



To give you an example of the power of the Holy Spirit after the day of Pentecost, think about Peter, one of the disciples of Jesus. He denied knowing Jesus three times in the one night. We understand from the bible about Peter, that he was a fisherman, a rough strong man. This same rough strong man denied Christ three times in one night because of the fear of man. Now jump forward in Peter's life to the day of Pentecost. Jesus had ascended to heaven and the Holy Spirit had now been given for all men. This same Peter who was so scared to acknowledge Jesus now stood up in front of three thousand men and gave testimony to Jesus and everyone's need to receive Him. He was a transformed man who we know from the bible never went back to being a coward in his faith. The same Holy Spirit that totally transformed Peter today wants to transform your life with His power.

Acts 1:8 "you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you"

So let's discover some more about the Holy Spirit and why His power is so important to our lives.

When the Holy Spirit came in the book of Acts one hundred and twenty men were praying in a room and they began to speak with new tongues, or what we term the language of the Holy Spirit. Let's read the account from the bible;

Acts 2:4 And they were all filled (diffused throughout their souls) with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other (different, foreign) languages (tongues), as the Spirit kept giving them clear and loud expression [in each tongue in appropriate words].



The Holy Spirit is all about surrender. If you never surrender you will never speak the words of the Holy Spirit. We must surrender our mouth to him and allow Him to speak through us. We do that by opening ourselves to the Holy Spirit and inviting Him to baptize us in His presence and fill us with His power and words. Then it is as simple as speaking or opening our mouth. Many people after receiving prayer for the baptism in the Holy Spirit say I can feel a wonderful feeling and I just can't get the words out of my mouth. My suggestion to these people is usually, surrender and just speak. You will know when it is the Holy Spirit, by faith or as an act of trust you must begin to speak. If it is not the Holy Spirit the words will dry up and you will forget it. Today right now in obedience, surrender and by faith **SPEAK**.

Let's read some more about what Jesus said about the Holy Spirit and the ability to speak with new tongues



John 14:15 If you [really] love Me, you will keep (obey) My commands.

John 14:16 And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengthener, and Standby), that He may remain with you forever--

John 14:17 The Spirit of Truth, Whom the world cannot receive (welcome, take to its heart), because it does not see Him or know and recognize Him. But you know and recognize Him, for He lives with you [constantly] and will be in you.

The creative God wants to use His creative words to bring life into every part of you and life around you. He will use your mouth to create by His Holy Spirit into the needs around your life as you worship Him in tongues. Where there is death life will come, where there is confusion peace will flow. He will use your mouth with His Holy Spirit words to worship, honor, and love and adore Him.

God knows what is needed and as you pray with the Holy Spirit and allow His words to come through your mouth you are allowing God to use your mouth to create in the situation. When I speak in my Holy Spirit language, do I know what I am saying, no, but I do know that power is flowing through me into the situation I am praying about and creating Gods will there.

So with my mind I love Jesus, with my body I can surrender in worship with arms raised to Him and then with my spirit I am praying in the power of the Holy Spirit tongue. Really everything I am, everything about me is now praying and surrendered to God in an amazing way. There will never be a more direct way to see answers to your prayers than allowing the Holy Spirit to speak through you into a situation by worship. He knows what is needed, He knows what to say and as you co-operate with Him, watch an amazing God answer your prayers.

One of the things I have found is that people who have control issues struggle to flow in the Holy Spirit. They are so accustomed to being in control of their lives they do not want to allow the Spirit of the living God to use their mouth. Maybe they prefer to be telling God what is needed and do not want to trust the Holy Spirit to speak through them. To flow with the Holy Spirit total trust is required, understanding it is only the power of God that makes the difference in everything not your control.

The Holy Spirit is clean pure and wonderful. He will never take you over; He will never possess you or overpower your mouth.

Acts 2:5 Now there were then residing in Jerusalem Jews, devout and God-fearing men from every country under heaven.

Acts 2:6 And when this sound was heard, the multitude came together and they were astonished and bewildered, because each one heard them [the apostles] speaking in his own [particular] dialect.

Acts 2:7 And they were beside themselves with amazement, saying, Are not all these who are talking Galileans?

Acts 2:8 Then how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own (particular) dialect to which we were born?

Acts 2:9 Parthians and Medes and Elamites and inhabitants of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and [the province of] Asia,

Acts 2:10 Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and the transient residents from Rome, both Jews and the proselytes [to Judaism from other religions],

Acts 2:11 Cretans and Arabians too--we all hear them speaking in our own native tongues [and telling of] the mighty works of God!

Speaking in the Holy Spirit creates life in you and life around you. To speak in tongues is a wonderful experience, which never ends. Through the power of the Holy Spirit working in your personal life, you feel free to express true praises. Your heart is unlocked and linked with God in an amazing way. Yes it is true intimacy with Jesus; your Spirit feels unlocked to speak praises to an incredible God who delivers heals and transforms our life. Someone once said that living life without the baptism of the Holy Spirit is like trying to live life without oxygen. Once you have breathed of the Holy Spirit and received of His power it is literally like fresh clean air blowing in and residing in your spirit or life.

Of course when you asked Jesus into your life the Holy Spirit came to you but the bible clearly speaks of a baptism in the Holy Spirit which is a further experience in what Jesus has for you, an infilling. The baptism of the Spirit creates life in you; He is life in you and brings life to every area you pray about with His words through tongues.

Let's talk about the Holy Spirit's ability to create new life in you and in the situations around your life. Have you ever been in a situation where you needed an answer but have not really known what to pray? Maybe confusion gripped you as voices came from everywhere telling you their opinions of what was needed, or you simply needed help in a situation. It can even seem sometimes as if there is no life where life is needed and like you really have no clue how to change things.

The good news is there is an answer; new life is available to you when you invite the Holy Spirit to fill you with His words of love or tongues. The Holy Spirit brings life where there has been death and hope where there has been hopelessness.



The bible says God creates with His words for example when creating the earth

Genesis 1:3 And God said, Let there be light; and there was light.

It also says;

Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and they who indulge in it shall eat the fruit of it
Matthew 12:37 For by your words you will be justified and acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned and sentenced.

Our tongue is a powerful force that can be used for evil or for good. I am sure you have seen the devastating effect negative words can have on a life. Maybe you have even been the victim of negative words that created death in you or a situation associated with you. When you speak the words of the Holy Spirit you create life, life and more life. The Holy Spirit never speaks words of death and never would bring destruction. Speaking in the power of the Holy Spirit releases the creative ability of an infinite God into your life through powerful worship. As you learn to flow in the Holy Spirit in this way there are other gifts of the Spirit talked about in the bible that become easier to flow with and are released to flow on a daily basis in your life. Prophecy, words of knowledge, discerning of spirits are a few of these gifts. When the Holy Spirit comes He brings his toolbox for you and easy access for His tools.
